PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 906 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 906. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 906 is advanced. LB 971.

CLERK: LB 971, I have no E & R. Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill. (See AM2976 on page 871 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, again, this is a minor amendment. It is on the level of an E & R amendment actually. It strikes Section 2-3613 of the statutes which is out of date. That section of the statute says within 60 days after April 24, 1978, eight members shall be appointed by the Governor to the initial board, and has other provisions about the initial board. But the initial board was appointed long ago and the general provisions for the election of members to the board are contained in other sections of the statutes. So I am just recommending the clean-up by the repeal of that particular statute.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Madam President and members of the Legislature, I have conferred with Senator Beutler on this or he has conferred with me, and I agree the language is no longer needed and would support his amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Does anyone else wish to speak to the Beutler amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Beutler? Closing is waived. We will vote on the Beutler amendment to LB 971. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the Beutler amendment to LB 971? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.
