ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays on the vote to advance the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1061 is advanced. Are there any items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Yes, Madam President. New resolution, LR 240 by Senator Rod Johnson. (Read brief summary.) Amendments to be printed to LB 556 from Senator Ashford; LB 353 from Senator Eeyer; LB 664 from Senator Conway. A confirmation report from the Natural Resources Committee, that's signed by Senator Rod Johnson. Amendments to be printed to LB 1120 by Senators Withem and Landis. Your Committee on Transportation reports LB 1178 to General File with committee amendments; LB 1214, General File with committee amendments; LB 981, General File; LB 1028, General File; LB 1206, General File with amendments; LB 1139, indefinitely postponed; LB 1176, General File. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 291 to Select File with amendments; LB 922, Select File with amendments; LB 306, Select File with amendments; LB 428, LB 447, LB 946, LB 338A, and LB 922A. Your Committee on Revenue, whose Chairperson is Senator Hall, reports LB 1120 indefinitely postponed; LB 273, LB 299, LB 460, LB 504, LB 524, LB 686, LB 804, LB 924, LB 972, LB 994, LB 995, LB 1083, LB 1094, LB 1119, LB 1254, indefinitely postponed; LR 4CA, LR 214CA, and LR 215CA indefinitely postponed. Appropriations Committee will conduct their hearing today in Room 1003; and Senator Hall would like to remind members of the Revenue Committee of an Executive Session this afternoon at 4:30 p.m. in 1126. SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues, before I make the motion to adjourn, I would like to let you know my intention is to put...LB 1120 will be on the agenda tomorrow. The Clerk will then reprint the amendments and have them available as quickly as possible. But LB 1120, the property tax bill, will be on the agenda tomorrow.
