LB 136 and LB 152, LB 515, LB 516, LB 621, LB 637, LB 640, LB 644 LB 688, LB 1118 and LB 1287 as indefinitely postponed. Those are all signed by Senator Chizek. Madam President, amendments to be printed to LB 1120 by Senator Haberman; Senator Ashford to LB 145. (See pages 896-99 of the Legislative Journal.)

Two study resolutions by Senators Haberman and Schimek. LR 241 calling for a study by the Government Committee on Judicial Nominating Commissions. And LR 242 by Senator Haberman asking the General Affairs Committee to conduct an interim study. Both of those will be referred to the Executive Board, Madam President.
