the body now, I don't think that's the right course to take. I think the Revenue Committee has set a course for us to follow. The media has all explained what that course will be.

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR WITHEM: That is what the people are watching and I think even though it's going to be longer and more treacherous to do that, I think we ought to stay on this road and examine what the policy alternatives that are being put forth in LB 1120 are and I will be not supporting the Hall amendment. I think there will be a time, I think there will be a time when we'll look at 1120, we will make a collective judgment that that is not the policy alternative we want to follow and when we make that determination, that will be the time for us to consider LB 1063, not at this point. So I will not be supporting the Hall amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Withem. Mr. Clerk, do you have an announcement?

CLERK: Madam President, I do. General Affairs Committee will have an Executive Session in 2022 at ten o'clock; General Affairs, 2022 at ten o'clock. And if I may very quickly, Madam President, priority bill designations. Senator Nelson has selected LB 672 as her priority bill; Retirement has selected LB 1040; Senator Schellpeper has selected LB 1130 on behalf of the General Affairs Committee; Senator Lamb has selected LB 1238; Senator Robak, LB 1098; and Senator Kristensen, LB 899.
