important that the body be aware of what we are doing here with the Athletic Commission, and that the procedures that we are utilizing may, very likely, have to be followed again next year, and it may be something that we'll have to look at in the interim as to how we deal with these mandated language changes, or changes in mandated substantive language in statute. So, with that, I'll move the advancement. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Ashford. Does anyone else wish to speak to this motion? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Moore?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Madam President. Once again Senator Robinson's point is...does not directly relate to this motion. I don't want you to be confused by that, if that particular issue is something you're concerned about. This motion has nothing to do with that. And I would ask for the adoption of the motion, and it will take 30 votes. The only other thing that I want to point out is the difference...you know, Senator...LB 1272 is a bill that has had a hearing, came out of committee, we included in our package. This particular bill we're talking about here is an idea that has not had a hearing, and our committee is of the opinion, particularly after last year when the body...if you're going to eliminate a state agency there certainly should be a hearing. And that's all this motion does. And I...I am...I thank Senator Withem for his words of support. And so, with that, I'd ask for the simple adoption of the motion so we can introduce the bill, and remind the body it will take 30 votes to do so.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. We will now vote on the motion to introduce a new bill. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce the new bill, Madam President. New bill. (Read LB 1294 by title for the first time. See page 1181 of the Legislative Journal.)
