LB 1058, 1138

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Again, Madam President and members, this amendment, the committee amendment, incorporates LB 1058 into LB 1138. LB 1058 is the bill that deals with the question of EMTs being able to administer advanced airways management work as well as the IVs. The IV question is the point in which there was some conflict over what was portrayed and what was not at the hearing, but, nevertheless, my feeling is we should go ahead and adopt the committee amendments and then advance the bill, and we will see if we can't work something out before Select File.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. We will now vote on the motion...or on the committee amendments, and we will have to have a roll call vote because the board is not working. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1193 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Morrissey. The committee amendments are adopted.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Yes, Madam President, a point of clarification. Since that was a roll call vote, I assumed I couldn't call the house if need be as I could on a normal board vote. I mean it is passed and all well and good, but if we have to do this again, on a normal board vote, you would know whether to call the house. A roll call, you won't necessarily if you are keeping track, and that is my reason for passing in case I needed to reconsider the vote at some time. But I would like a clarification. I mean do we treat that, when the board is not working and you do an initial roll call vote that wasn't requested like that, do we treat that like a board vote then?

PRESIDENT MOUL: You do have the prerogative to put the house under call.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: No...even after the roll call vote. I mean, yeah, after the roll call vote in place of a board vote, I can call it. Like if we are sitting here watching the board, you can see there is not enough people around and you don't have the votes and you know, all right, I had better call the house. When they are rolling it like that and someone talks to you and you lose count, you have no idea, so you are at a disadvantage
