PRESIDENT MOUL: Next amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Moore. Senator, I have a note that you wish to withdraw. No. AM3276 by Senator Moore, found on page 1169 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: This is the issue this morning I spoke of regarding the sales tax reporting and matching up the farm machinery sales tax exemption and refund with the 775 sales tax refund. As I mentioned this morning, it was my understanding the Department of Revenue was drafting up to make those things match up. I have yet to get that back from them, but I also now have been told that that is going to be incorporated into a later, shall we call a technical amendment that Senator Warner is going to introduce later, and so given that, I, assuming that is actually in that amendment, at this time I will withdraw that amendment, Mr. Clerk.
