Appropriations Committee has got a handle on what's going on, and they can keep track of these buildings and the leases and everything, where now it's in such a shambles that nobody knows what's going on, leases all over the state. So I ask for the advancement of the bill, and I will work with those concerned and we'll draft an amendment on Select File that, one thing we hadn't caught that was brought by Senator Moore and Senator Wesely and concerns of Senator Bernard-Stevens, and get that incorporated in the bill and get the passage of it. So I ask for the...move the bill over to Select File. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Peterson's closing on the advancement of LB 1241. We'll now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 1241.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 1241 advances. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, new resolution. LR 281, by Senators Crosby, Baack, and Ashford. (Read brief summary of resolution.) Explanation of vote for Senator Morrissey. Amendments to LB 1172 by Senator Wickersham; Senator Moore to LB 958; Senator Lamb to LB 958, and communication from the Governor. (Read communication re: LB 898, and LB 989.) That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 1406-10 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now proceed to LB 835.

CLERK: Mr. President, 835 was a bill introduced by Senators Wesely and Lynch. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 23 of last year, at that time was referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have Banking Committee amendments pending. (See AM0874 on page 1225 of the Journal, First Session, 1991.)

SPEAKER BAACK: To the Chair of the Banking Committee, Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I believe Senator Abboud is going to make a
