

SENATOR LAMB: Madam Chair, I would call for the previous question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Do I see sufficient seconds? I do. We'll now vote on the motion to cease debate. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Have you all voted? Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Madam Chair, I would ask for a call of the house. I really believe people want to cease debate. Roll call, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 7 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Senators, please check in, the house is under call. Senator Landis, Lindsay and Ashford, please check in. Senator Pirsch, Senator Robak, Senator Robinson, please check in. Senator Rogers, Senator Coordsen, Senator Schimek. Senator Hall, Senator Lowell Johnson, Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Rod Johnson, would you please check in. Would the senators please be seated so we can proceed with the roll call vote. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk. We are voting on ceasing debate on the motion to place LB 1172 on General File.
