PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 946 is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Will, I have E & R amendments pending, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 1138.
