

profession who feel that there should be regulation, those who support this approach, those who oppose this approach, would be on notice that when hearings are conducted, it would be in their best interest, economic interest, professional interest to participate and give whatever information they have to offer. So I am asking that you support this bracket motion. I doubt that there is anybody on this floor who, if they understood what this bill does, if they had read it carefully, or just superficially, could say that it constitutes good legislation, and that in voting for it, they would be proud to take it as it is written to their constituents and say I gave this vote knowing what is in this bill, knowing that we make the Secretary of State a virtual czar, knowing that the bill, based on prior attorney's general opinions is unconstitutional, knowing that and having had it said to me, I, nevertheless, voted for the bill and I am proud of it and that is the kind of representative you have. Nobody would make that approach, but that, in effect, is what would be done if we move this bill as it stands now. I am asking that you vote to bracket. And, Madam President, because we have so few people here, may I ask for a call of the house?

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.
