CLERK: Madam President, 529A introduced by Senator Lindsay. (Read title.) It was reported directly to General File, as is normally the case.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We'll pass over LB 529A and start then with LB 447A.

CLERK: LB 447A by Senator Bernard-Stevens. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill by Senator Bernard-Stevens.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Madam President, members of the body, this amendment simply does what the amendment that the body agreed to and attached to LB 447 and advanced to Final Reading the other day. The amendment that we agreed to was a transfer of the funds from the Supreme Court on juvenile service funding to the Crime Commission. This amendment simply puts into the A bill that action which we did last week on 447 and this, obviously, would need to be agreed to so we're consistent with what we did on 447 and we need to advance the A bill so it can get caught up at some point. With that, I urge the body's adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Madam President, members of the body, I have a question for Senator Bernard-Stevens. How much additional General Fund money will this bill need?

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Zero. This amendment will cost zero. It is just simply a transfer.

SENATOR ROBINSON: That is a trans...that was the question, thank you.
