CLERK: 24 ayes, 11 nays to indefinitely postpone LB 1135, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1135 is indefinitely postponed. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Two items, Madam President, thank you. Amendments to LB 719A by Senator Moore; Senator Kristensen amendments to LB 835. That's all that I have. (See pages 1841-44.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: We'll proceed with LB 1240.

CLERK: LB 1240 was a bill introduced by Senator Hartnett and a number of members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22 of this year, at that time referred to the Revenue Committee. It was advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President and members. LB 1240 was brought to the committee by Senator Hartnett. The committee amendments rewrite the bill and there are some changes to the bill as it was introduced.
