SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Horgan. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 1001. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator...of the motion to advance the bill, I should say.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, amendments to be printed, Senator Schellpeper amendments to LB 201; Senator Haberman on LB 1114; Senator Schrock to LB 1011; Senator Schmit to LB 1114; Senator Landis and Hall to LB 1248. (See pages 1978-82 of the Legislative Journal).

Mr. President, two new resolutions, LR 427, Senators Lynch, Ashford, Rasmussen; and LR 428 by Senators Wehrbein and Cudaback. (Read brief description, see pages 1982-84 of the Legislative Journal.) Both those will be laid over.

Attorney General's Opinion to Senator Horgan (Re. LB 958. See pages 1985-86 of the Journal.) And a confirmation hearing report by the Business and Labor Committee signed by Senator Coordsen as Chair. And, Mr. President, Senator Will has amendments to LB 1011. (See pages 1987-88 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to...on General File to LB 431.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 431 was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely, Smith and Schellpeper. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 18 of last year. At that time it was referred to the Health Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending. Senator, do you want to offer your amendment to the committee, no, okay.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members, what I'd like to do is give a brief background to the issue and then go to an amendment that Senator Bohlke and I have to the committee amendments if that's all right.
