SENATOR CONWAY: You have heard the closing. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments to LB 431 vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 431. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CONWAY: The committee amendments are adopted. We are back to LB 431. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I'd just answer any questions, if there are any on the bill, be happy to do that.

SENATOR CONWAY: I see no questions. I have no lights. Do you have a closing?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. President and members, it was indicated by the Clerk some 20 senators have been excused. I would hope that we would be able to get an adequate number to advance the bill. Senator Bohlke and I have spent a lot of time on this. This is a bill that has been around three years, originally was some work by Senator Lynch. I would truly hope we could take some steps forward to start vaccine made available for kids to be immunized to keep these childhood diseases from threatening our state once again. I'd ask your support for the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CONWAY: You have heard the closing. All those in favor of the advancement of LB 431 vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, do you want to record?

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 431.

SENATOR CONWAY: LB 431 is advanced. We will move to LB 431A.
