SENATOR ROBINSON: I want to hear it from you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'm sorry, I didn't hear the question, Senator.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I'd like to know the amount of General Fund money and for how many years.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The General Fund money should only be for two years, Senator, and it's for the amounts, as stated in the amendment.

SENATOR ROBINSON: A hundred and seventy-six thousand for '92-93, 353 for '93-94, is that correct?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, the A bill had 300,000 for '92-93, and 470...465 for '93-94.

SENATOR ROBINSON: And that's all General Fund money.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And that's all General Fund money. It's my understanding, and I would need to clarify this for sure, but it's my understanding that as the emission fees kick in, that that can be used to reimburse the General Fund. But before I represent that to you absolutely, Senator, I want to...I'd want to check on that.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I'd just like to reiterate what Senator Wehrbein said, as everyone knows, we're way over on the A bills. It's going to compete with your A bills. And we're just sinking ourselves further in debt, folks. Better start taking a good look at it. You can kiss about anything good-bye that you have on the...on the floor now. I oppose the...I oppose 1257A.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Does anyone else wish to speak to LB 1257A? Seeing none, Senator Will, would you make the motion, please.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1257A to E & R for engrossment.
