only the plate, but the stickers and so on. The last time we did that was in the 1988 session. Those have increased. This is a 35 cent increase to cover, if we want to be able to issue license plates in 1993, we need to be able to, or must be able to pay for those things to cover the increased costs of manufacturing, distribution, and the purchase of the stickers. This is LB 1065, just as we had through committee that came out with no dissenting votes or anything like that, there were no opponents. And if we want to have license plates in 1993, we need to be able to raise this 35 cents to do that. With that, I would urge the body to return this bill for specific amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the motion to return? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to return. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the motion to return. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the motion to return? Record, Mr. Clerk.
