SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 245A, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2188 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 8 nays, 3 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 245A, with the emergency clause attached, passes. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, thank you. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 360 as correctly engrossed; LB 899 as correctly engrossed; LB 1063, correctly engrossed; LB 835, correctly engrossed; LB 339, LB 431, LB 556, LB 556A, LB 1001, LB 1098, LB 1192, and LB 1192A all reported correctly engrossed. And, Mr. President, bills read earlier this evening on Final Reading have been presented to the Governor. (Re. LB 308, LB 308A, LB 677, LB 677A, LB 706, LB 706A, LB 734, LB 734A, LB 877, LB 877A, LB 982, LB 982A, and LB 1000.) That's all that I have. (See pages 2188-90 of the Legislative Journal.)
