SPEAKER BAACK: LB 447A passes. We will now go to LB 1006E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1006 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: I'm going to ask the senators to check in, please, before we vote on this measure. Would the senators all check in, please. We are waiting for Senators Conway, Robinson, and Kristensen. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1006, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2196 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 1006, with the emergency clause attached, passes. We'll now do LB 1006AE.

CLERK: (Read LB 1006A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1006A, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 2196-97 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 1106A, with the emergency clause attached, passes. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 428, LB 428A, LB 946, LB 1057, LB 1111, LB 573, LB 245, LB 245A, LB 366, LB 366A, LB 447, LB 447A, LB 1006A, and LB 1006. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 562 correctly engrossed, LB 1241 correctly engrossed. Senator Kristensen would like to add his name to LB 672 as cointroducer. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (See page 2197 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now simply stand at ease until the rest of the bills come back from the Bill Drafters Office. I'm
