SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President and members of the Legislature, this morning the Transportation Committee brings to you an appointment to the Motor Vehicle Industry Dealer Licensing Board. Mr. John A. Rickerts did appear before our committee, candidly answered the questions and the committee certainly does recommend his appointment and confirmation to the Motor Vehicle Industry Dealer Licensing Board and I would move for his confirmation. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Does anyone wish to speak to this confirmation report? Seeing none, we will now vote on the confirmation report. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the confirmation report from the Transportation Committee.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The confirmation report is adopted. We'll now return to LR 422.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, LR 422 was introduced by Senator Rod Johnson. It is found in the Journal on page 1806.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Thank you, Madam President, members, this resolution recognizes a transfer of property from Robert Marcotte to the Game and Parks Commission. It is 462.5 acres in Keya Paha County that borders the Thomas Creek Wildlife Management area. A question has been raised why we need to actually vote on the transfer of this property to the Game and Parks Commission. In last years mainline appropriations bill, LB 843 in a section, on page 190 it says, any gift or device of real property in excess of \$10,000 shall be approved by the Governor and the Legislature before its acceptance. What we're asking the body to do is to accept this property on behalf of the state and the Marcotte family to be used as a management...wildlife management area in Keya Paha County. So with that, unless there are any questions, I would move for the adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Johnson. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Thank you, Madam Chair and members. I will not
