LEGISLATIVE BILL 850

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board; to amend section 60-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change internal references; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-1403. (1) The board shall have full power to:

(a) Regulate regulate the issuance and revocation of licenses in accordance with and subject to the provisions of this act, to perform sections 60-1401.01 to 60-1440:

(b) Perform all acts and duties provided for herein in such sections necessary to the administration and enforcement of this act, and to make such sections: and

(c) Make and enforce rules and regulations relating to the administration of but not inconsistent with <u>such sections</u>. (2) the previsions of this act. The board shall adopt a seal, which

(2) the previsions of this act. The board shall adopt a seal, which may be either an engraved or ink stamp seal, with the words Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board and such other devices as the board may desire included thereon by which it shall authenticate the acts of its office. Copies of all records and papers in the office of the board, under the hand and seal of its office, shall be received in evidence in all cases equally and with like effect as the original.

(3) Investigators employed by the board are hereby given authority to inspect any vehicles, trailers, or motorcycles found in any licensed motor vehicle, motorcycle, or trailer dealer's established place or places of business.

Sec. 2. That original section 60-1403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
