SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: (Mike not activated immediately.) ...George Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer we have Chaplain Harland Johnson. Harland.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Harland. I now call to order the second day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. Roll call. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Are there any corrections to the Journal?

ASSISTANT CLERK: No corrections at this time.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any corrections later? No, not...no corrections, okay. We need a motion to adopt temporary rules. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move that the rules as now in our possession be adopted for today only, Thursday, January 7, 1993.
