**SPEAKER BAACK:** Senator Haberman.

**SENATOR HABERMAN:** Mr. President and members of the body, LR 10 reads, Whereas, Eustis, Nebraska is a German community established in 1886 and it has a present population of 452 people. Eustis is located 60 miles north of McCook and 60 miles south of North Platte. The people of Eustis and the surrounding community make summer sausage, pressed wurst, bratwurst, leberwurst, blutwurst, drier sausage, Polish sausage, deer sausage, pork sausage, oatmeal sausage, scrapple and head cheese. And, Whereas, the community of Eustis sets aside the second Saturday of June to celebrate Wurst Tag or sausage day, it is now resolved that the Legislature in the Ninety-Third Session, First Session, that the Village of Eustis, in keeping with its German heritage of sausage making, is hereby given the official designation "Sausage Capital of Nebraska", and that this resolution be sent to Patricia R. Keller. For those of you who do not know scrapple, it is cornmeal boiled with scraps of pork and after sitting it's sliced and fried. For you folks that don't know head cheese, it is jellied, seasoned meat made from the head and feet of hogs. If you would like to have some, I will try to have some for you brought to the Chambers. I would greatly appreciate your support in voting green on this resolution for Eustis, Nebraska out in my legislative district. Thank you, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Haberman. Anyone else wishing to comment on the legislative resolution by Senator Haberman?
