SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK:    Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer today for chaplain, we have Pastor Homer Clements from the St. Paul United Methodist Church here in Lincoln. Pastor Clements.

PASTOR HOMER CLEMENTS:    (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK:    Thank you, Pastor Clements. I now call to order the eleventh day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. Roll call.

CLERK:    I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Are there corrections to the Journal?

CLERK:    No corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Before we proceed to items for the record, I would like to introduce some guests of the Legislature today.
