PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain is Pastor Andrew Rollins of Quinn Chapel in Lincoln. Pastor Rollins.

Retirement Committee, chaired by Senator Horgan, reports LB 107 to General File; and Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee reports LB 81 to General File with amendments, all signed by the respective Chairs.
