CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 49.

CLERK: LB 69, Mr. President, introduced by Senator Wickersham. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7, referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. LB 69 is a very simple bill designed to promote efficiency in the administration of the county courts and the district courts. It promotes efficiency by providing that in the specialized circumstances when relief sought is not providable by the county court, in this case specifically an injunction that the entire case matter is transferred automatically to the district court without repleading the action or without the payment of additional fees. The bill is specific to situations when the relief requested is not within...is exclusively within the jurisdiction of the district court, that is actions over \$10,000 and also, in this case, injunctions. It will promote efficiency and I urge your support of the bill.
