SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robak. Mr. Clerk, you do have an amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lindsay would move to amend Senator, AM0119. (Lindsay amendment appears on pages 449-50 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. AM0119 should be on your desk. It was passed out a while back. What this amendment would do is to adopt the portion of Senator Janssen's LB 402 onto this bill. Senator Janssen brought LB 402 to raise fees on behalf of the Fire Marshal to raise some fees for...in the Fire Marshal's Office. The Judiciary Committee killed that bill because it opposed a portion of the increase in those fees. There was a portion of that dealing with inspections of plans and those types of things that the committee agreed with and the committee killed LB 402 with the understanding that they asked that I offer this amendment to Senator Robak's bill. Senator Robak is familiar with it and does not have an objection to it with the understanding that this amendment would be offered to LB 251 to get that portion of it which the Judiciary Committee agreed with it and that is what this bill does now. If you'll notice the primary increase, it's on the last page of the amendment which allows for an inspection of plans. It's a dollar fee per \$10,000 of valuation and it increases the maximum fee under that provision from 100 to 500. But this amendment does limit in the first page, lines 4 and 5, it shows that the fees to be established and assessed by the Fire Marshal in this provision shall not exceed the actual cost of the inspection. So what it does, it does tie the fee into the services being performed on the inspection of those plans. With that I'd be happy to try to answer any questions concerning the amendment and would urge that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Discussion of the amendment by Senator Lindsay. Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Senator Lindsay, did you say you were amending LB 401 into this bill?

SENATOR LINDSAY: A portion of LB 401.

SENATOR MOORE: And is 401 advanced from committee?
