PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Does anyone wish to address this bill? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Schellpeper? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the motion to advance LB 57. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 57.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 57 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Madam President. I have a series of hearing notices from the Health and Human Services Committee, all signed by Senator Wesely as Chair. Senator Hall has amendments to be printed to LB 559.
