Health and Human Services whose Chair is Senator Wesely reports
LB 377 to General File with amendments; LB 536, General File
with amendments. Those are signed by Senator Wesely.
Government Committee reports LB 236 to General File; LB 44,
General File with amendments; LB 90, General File with
amendments. Those are signed by Senator Schimek. Judiciary
Committee whose Chair is Senator Lindsay reports LB 462 to
General File; LB 593, General File; LB 110, General File with
amendments; LB 430, General File with amendments; LB 598,
General File with amendments; LB 592, indefinitely postponed;
LR 7CA as indefinitely postponed. That's all that I have at

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will now proceed with
Item 8 on the agenda, General File. LB 25.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 25 was a bill originally introduced
by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on
January 7, referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File. The
bill was discussed on February 5. An amendment by Senator
Chambers was adopted at that time, Madam President. I do have
pending an amendment to the bill at this time.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Chambers, would you bring us up to date
on the bill first, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Madam President, and members of
the Legislature, this bill was discussed extensively the other
day. And, Mr. Clerk, is that amendment the one being offered by
