PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Vernon Jacobs of First Lutheran Church in Omaha, from Senator Pirsch's district. Pastor Jacobs.
