SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Schimek, I appreciate that and I will push my button on here again and, if I need some additional time. Part of this is for the record because a lot of people when we recodify are going to look at the record and say, how can I find these things in the future and the revisor's office has gone to a tremendous amount of work to put these things in the proper order and make the right rereferences. Committee Counsel Mike Hybl has just done a super job of putting this together for you. If you have any questions you probably are best to talk to Mike on a one-to-one basis. He is the one who did these sorts of handouts and who can quickly find you the changes and tell you. I'll be glad to try to do them on the floor as well. If you look through the next appendix, and that's appendix number 5, these are the significant amendments. These are the ones that probably, if there is anything that is of substance in the recodification, you will find this in appendix number 5. For example, the very first one here is dealing with the liability of guest passengers, the guest statute. We make no changes in the guest statute but we take it out of the Rules of the Road and put it into the civil procedure area with particular causes of action so it's an easier section to find. A lot of people had trouble dealing with those sections because they couldn't find them. The same way goes, for example, liability, if it's for leased trucks, trailers, liability for damages, we've taken all those and put them in Section 25 instead of section, in Chapter number 60 which are the Rules of the Road. There are several of those, many of those sections, for example, are the speeding sections that we've changed. We restate the speeding points and how many points you lose. We do that in a couple of sections because people over the last 20 years, and if you go back even further, over the last 50 years when they've introduced bills and so on, have restated points. Maybe they couldn't find it in the statute earlier so they wanted to restate those and so we'll see some redundancy. In some places you've got the same section of the law in there twice and so we tried to repeal those out to do them. Some of them have been reordered to reword based on just the way, for example, we've got one Supreme Court case that they construed the language differently than what we thought they had. That's been redone and there has been some small change in that. However if it's of a major change, you will not find it in 370, you will find that in LB 575 which will follow. The final appendix is appendix number 6. This sets out the sections
