delegation of legislative authority. And so, last year we should have done this, however, with the tax issue, we didn't do it. We were looking at regulations that were in effect on the first day of January 1991. And we've operated for two years on the old regulations. It's now time for us to go to January 1, 1993 and update our regulations. With that, Madam President, I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Does anyone wish to address the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to adopt committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the committee amendments? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Kristensen, for opening on the bill itself.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President. I would just again renew my, for the record, renew my explanation that LB 410 is our annual update, that we're one year behind on already, that would establish and adopt the federal regulations with regards to motor carriers and the transportation of hazardous materials. And I would urge its advancement to E & R Initial. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Does anyone wish to address the bill itself? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Kristensen? Closing is waived.
