

February 22, 1993 LB 100, 332

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Haberman. The motion is to advance LB 332 to Select File. All those in favor please vote aye, those opposed no. A record vote has been requested. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 713 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 0 nays on advancement of LB 332, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The motion carries. The bill is advanced. Proceed to Select File, LB 100.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Will, thank you, E & R amendments have been adopted already. The next motion on the bill is by Senator Withem. Senator Withem moved to indefinitely postpone the bill, that laid it over on February 3.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: I would withdraw the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senators Bohlke, Byars and Beutler, page 522, Senator, of the Journal.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. President, members, would you tell me which number we're...

CLERK: AM225, Senator. You've got a second amendment up here.

SENATOR BOHLKE: I'd like that first one withdrawn and move on to the second amendment.

CLERK: Okay. Mr. President, Senators Bohlke, Byars and Beutler would move to amend with AM462. (See pages 714-18 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay, Senator Bohlke, please.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. President, members, once again we are back with an amendment to try to appease some of the concerns that were expressed originally on LB 100. What the amendment now does, essentially, is say that if a student and a parent agree
