SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Warner. You've heard the closing on the advancement. A machine vote has been requested. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 320. Senator Wesely requested a machine vote. All those in favor of advancement vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
