SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I would move the advancement of LB 140 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: A machine vote has been requested on the advancement of LB 140. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I would like to ask...request a call of the house and a roll call vote in regular order.
