SPEAKER BAACK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer today we have...for chaplain, we have Pastor Mark Fry from Bethany Lutheran Church from Elkhorn, Nebraska. Pastor Fry.

Urban Affairs Committee whose Chair is Senator Hartnett reports LB 388 indefinitely postponed, likewise with LB 485, LB 486, LB 487, LB 581, LB 680, those all signed by Senator Hartnett. Health and Human Services Committee whose Chair is Senator Wesely reports LB 520 to General File with amendments. It was signed by Senator Wesely as Chair. Government Committee reports LB 472 to General File, that is signed by Senator Schimek. Judiciary reports LB 435 to General File, LB 262 General File with amendments, LB 133 indefinitely postponed as is LB 142, LB 400, LB 405, LB 535, LB 549, LB 550 and LB 691, all reported indefinitely postponed.
