

February 24, 1993 LB 113, 138, 138A, 417

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Before we proceed, I would like to introduce the doctor of the day. We have Dr. Andrew Blankenau and he is from Bloomfield, from Senator Day's district. Doctor, would you please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. We will now proceed to Item 5 on the agenda and Final Reading. Members, please take your seats for Final Reading. Members, please take your seats so we may have Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 113.

CLERK: (Read LB 113 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 113 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the passage of LB 113. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 761-62 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 4 nays, 7 present and not voting, 10 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 113 passes. We'll now go to LB 417E.

CLERK: (Read LB 417E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 417 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 762-63 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 417 with the emergency clause passes. We'll now go to LB 138E.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 138, I have a motion from Senator Will. Senator Will would move to suspend Rule 8, Section 5, so as to permit consideration of LB 138 and LB 138A on Final Reading.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.
