SPEAKER BAACK: The motion succeeds. We will now vote on the emergency clause for LB 138. A roll call vote in reverse order has been requested. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 774-75 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 16 nays on the passage of LB 138.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 138 passes with the emergency clause. We will now go to LB 138A with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 138A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 138A, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 775-76 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 7 nays, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 138A with the emergency clause attached passes. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 113, LB 417, LB 138 and LB 138A. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President, thank you. LB 240A. (Read for the first time by title. See page 776 of the Legislative Journal.)
