SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us as chaplain today we have Pastor Dave Sellars from the Northern Heights Baptist Church from Norfolk, which is in Senator Day's District. Pastor.
