

that you don't lose any points on your motor vehicle operator's license for any violations to do them. Senator Horgan had LB 434 and this applies to registered vehicles. The requirement is they've got to be properly registered when they're operated on the roadways and the public highways. His bill merely goes in and says, if they're parked, they also have to be properly registered and lawfully registered to do that. That makes up the bills. If you have individual senators that you want to ask questions about their bill, please do so. If you want to have any particular issue about a section or sections, it's been drafted so that you can divide the question easily and make that discussion. I would be most happy to go through any of the committee amendments and discuss this with you again. The reason for putting these bills into this is threefold. One, it's easier for the bill drafters and the Revisor of Statutes to do it. Two, it gives this body an easier time to focus on the rules of the road all at once, and because many of these sections fit together. And third is that if, instead clogging consent calendar where you're going to have a very limited time to discuss any one bill, we wanted to give everybody the opportunity to have full discussion. In fact, this is probably a more open way to do it. These are on General File. These bills did not have major problems within the committee but we certainly want to give everybody the opportunity to look at them and would be happy...Committee Counsel, Mike Hybl, would also be happy to answer any specific problems or questions that you may have. And this is the committee amendments. Once these are adopted, Madam President, if they're adopted by the body, I'll then open on the bill and give you the other changes. There are probably more changes in the major bill than there are the committee amendments. This is a process that we hope the body is comfortable with and would be glad to answer any questions. Thank you.
