PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Withem. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 453. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 453.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 453 is advanced. I would now recognize Senator McKenzie for a point of personal privilege.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Madam President. I have been asked by Senator Day's staff to inform you that today is her birthday, and since you've already eaten the doughnuts, you have some memory of that. For your information, Senator Day was invited to fly to Washington, D.C. this morning to meet with President Clinton as a small businessperson from Nebraska. So she is on a fast track and hopefully having a birthday she will always remember, but she did ask me to ask you to enjoy her birthday in her absence and to remember her today. Thank you.

That is signed by Senator Landis. And Health Committee reports LB 344, LB 470 and LB 784 indefinitely postponed, those signed by Senator Wesely. New A bill, LB 608A by Senator Wesely.
