CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Elmer has amendments to LB 345 to be printed. Senator Beutler has selected LB 389 as his priority bill. CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1031 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 91, with the emergency clause attached, passes. We'll go to LB 112E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 112E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 112, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
