SPEAKER BAACK: LB 215 passes. We'll now go to LB 288E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 288E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 288 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1035 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 288 with the emergency clause attached passes. We'll go to LB 356E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 356E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 356 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1035-36 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 356 with the emergency clause attached passes. Before we proceed to the next bill which does have an amendment, I would like to make a brief announcement that senator priority bills and committee priority bills have to be to us by the close of work tomorrow about noon. They have to be in at that point. And then after that by noon the next day then the Speaker priority bills will be designated. So tomorrow noon is the deadline. Mr. Clerk, LB 311.
