SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Withem. Any other discussion on the Warner amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to return LB 311 to Select File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill is returned. Senator Warner, on your amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would just move that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on the Warner amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Warner amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 56 and LR 57. We'll now go to Item 7, General File, LB 677A. We need to readvance the bill. I got a little carried away up here. Okay, Senator Warner, would you like to make a motion to readvance the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Move that LB 311 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to readvance LB 311. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is readvanced. We'll now go to Item 7 on the agenda, General File. Oh, do you have items for the record first?
