LB 597.      Senator Withem has selected LB 94 as one of the Education Committee priority bills. Judiciary Committee reports LB 51 to General File with amendments. That's offered by Senator Lindsay. Health and Human Services reports LB 152 to General File with amendments; LB 429, General File with amendments; LB 505, General File with amendments. Those are signed by Senator Wesely as Chair of the committee. (See pages 1037-43 of the Legislative Journal.)
