PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Fred Tedder, of the Church of the Nazarene in Omaha, in Senator Pirsch's District. Pastor Tedder.

PASTOR TEDDER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Pastor Tedder. I now call to order the forty-fourth day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Journal is approved. Are there any messages, reports, or announcements.

CLERK: Madam President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 268 and recommend that the same be placed on Select File, LB 191, LB 590, LB 23, LB 377A, LB 364A, LB 629, LB 346, all on Select File, some having Enrollment and Review amendments attached, all signed by Senator Hohenstein. Education Committee reports LB 597 to General File. Transportation Committee reports LB 424 to General File with amendments. (See pages 1051-56 of the Legislative Journal.)

New A bill, LB 305A. (Read for the first time by title. See page 1056 of the Legislative Journal.) A series of priority bill designations; Senator Wickersham has selected LB 302; Senator Chambers, LB 717; Senator Hall, LB 598; Senator Coordsen, LB 757; Senator Baack, LB 235; Senator Moore, as Chair of Appropriations, LB 322 and LB 507; Senator Abboud, LB 754 and LB 757 (sic) (Journal shows LB 248); and Senator Pirsch has selected LB 421 as her priority bill, Madam President.
