PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. Does anyone else wish to speak to this resolution? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to adopt LR 66. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of LR 66.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LR 66 is adopted. We will pass over LR 67 and proceed to General File, LB 305A.

CLERK: Madam President, 305A was a bill introduced by Senator McKenzie. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Yes, Madam President, and members of the body, LB 305A is the appropriations bill which goes with LB 305. It appropriates funds for the rest of this '93-94 year and then into '94-95, as was discussed the day we talked about LB 305 on the floor. It does not extend past the 12-cent limit for this A bill in particular. So if there is no further discussion, I would move we advance 305A so it can catch up with LB 305.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator McKenzie. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 305A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 305A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 305 is advanced. LB 453A.
