PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Pastor John Folly, chaplain of the Lutheran Community Hospital at Norfolk in Senator Connie Day's district. Pastor Folly.
