SPEAKER BAACK:      LB 508, with the emergency clause attached, passes.      Before we go to the next bill, I would like to make a special announcement. We do have a special birthday tomorrow. Our Sergeant at Arms, Sally, will be 84 years old tomorrow. Sally. Mr. Clerk, LB 106.

ASSISTANT CLERK:      Mr. President, with respect to LB 106, I do have a motion from Senator Byars, he'd move to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK:      Senator Byars.

SENATOR BYARS:      Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker.      And I apologize for needing to pull this back to Select File, but unfortunately I found in amending this bill on Select File, trying to accommodate people and create a nonadversarial type relationship, I did just exactly that, I created some language in the bill which, when inserted in like legislation, in the State of Maine, created problems, unfortunately for the very people that we're trying to help, and that's the new car dealers of the State of Nebraska. I would ask that you return this bill to Select File for a specific amendment, to strike the language which we had put in, on Select File, stating that a general price adjustment shall not constitute retaliation for purposes of this section. What we have found, and I'm not going to belabor the point because I also don't want to be adversarial, but we found that by allowing this type of language there have been manufacturers in this country have used that to be able to increase prices arbitrarily, to cover what we've been trying to accomplish to get fair warning reimbursement for the dealers of the state. So I would ask that the bill be returned for specific amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK:      Discussion on the motion to return?      Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Byars?      He waives closing. We will vote on the motion to return. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.      Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.
