

specialty pesticides. The amendment came down about the time that the A bill was being read on 588, and we did not want to hold the process up at that particular time. You have on your desk a pink sheet of paper, the first...first page is basically what it does, and the second page is the condensed version of the amendment. The amendment itself is 17 pages long, because, as we all are aware, that's how some things turn out in bill drafting. But I wanted you to make...wanted to do this so that you understood that there's nothing included in this proposed amendment to 267 that is covering up anything at all, it simply provides a definitional section, if you'll turn to the second page of the handout, what in fact a specialty pesticide is. It should make the enforcement...application and enforcement of LB 588 somewhat easier. So, with that, I would encourage the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, we visited about this on several occasions, the Department of Agriculture. Both these bills came through the Ag Committee, the FIFRA bill and LB 267, and we have no problem with this amendment Senator Coordsen brings. It provides a little clarification for the retail merchants, and so we're in support of this...this amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Dierks. Any other discussion? Seeing none, Senator Coordsen, would you like to close? Waives closing. We will now vote on the Coordsen amendment to LB 267. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
